A peer-to-peer solution, the Java™-based EverLink application brings new levels of flexibility and ease-of-use to private and secure electronic mail, file transfers and real time chat over Wide Area Networks (WANs), the Internet or intranets.

EverLink is now configured to be user-focused, rather than feature-focused. The new set-up wizard allows total installation in less than ten minutes. The new user interface reduces training time and enhances productivity, and gives users the flexibility to easily configure the software to meet their individual needs. Users can create buddy lists, instantly view the status of other users, and easily send and receive messages, files and documents.

Communication is instant and secure, because EverLink is a peer-to-peer connection and doesn’t require routing communications through a server. EverLink also provides the capability to remotely access data and communicate with another authorized user through a Web browser, eliminating the need to install client software on the remote user’s system.

EverLink’s Direct Conversation™ feature allows two EverLink users to communicate, or “chat”, in real time with full privacy and security. Sessions are authorized through digital certificates and protected by SSL. The Direct Conversation feature of EverLink delivers instant business messaging as a strategic business tool.

Benefits to the Organization

EverLink is an affordable, secure alternative or complement to many other methods of providing remote network access, including dedicated leased lines, remote access servers (RAS), VPNs, and direct dial-up.

EverLink enables systems administrators to authorize *individual* user access to designated areas of information behind the corporate firewall, rather than granting all admitted users universal access to the entire network. This distinguishing feature provides unprecedented control over network access from both inside and outside the organization's firewall.

EverLink utilizes advanced security technologies including passwords, secure transport with Secure Sockets Layer (SSL), x.509 digital certificates, activity logs, RSA® data encryption and security level up to 168-bit.

EverLink is available immediately and is sold exclusively through Value Added Resellers and Systems Integrators. EverLink is sold in a variety of license configurations, depending on the number of users, making it configurable for companies of all sizes. For example, prices range from \$845 for 25 users, \$4,195 for 200 users, \$15,995.00 for 5,000 users, and \$19,995.00 for 10,000 users. - *EntryGuard Server* protects internal networks from unauthorized access while allowing authorized users to communicate securely and privately with specific sites inside the firewall. EntryGuard also logs all transactions across the firewall, adding an additional layer of security. The server lists the addresses for EverLink users' office home pages, authenticates the client's EverLink Owner's Certificate, and offers global search capabilities.
